**Position Descriptions:**

**President: Student leader of FYSH programs and engagement**

The FYSH President partners with Hillel staff to role model a supportive, inclusive, and enthusiastic atmosphere during FYSH programs, meetings, and events. The FYSH president is an instrumental role to implementing IU Hillel's overall mission and values to "create a Jewish home away from home". The FYSH president is expected to meet with his/her advisor once a week to collaboratively create engaging and relevant content for FYSH meetings.

**Vice President:** The VP serves as a reliable resource to the President. The VP is expected to attend bi-weekly meetings with a Hillel advisor and FYSH President to brainstorm and create engaging Jewish programs.

**Engagement Chair(s):** are active partners with Hillel staff in outreaching to new students to Hillel on IU's campus. Engagement Chair(s) take ownership of Hillel outreach initiatives including but not limited to: tabling on campus, coffee meetups with new students, and welcoming students into Shabbat and other Hillel programs.

**Social Programming Chair:** The Social Programming Chair provides strong organizational skills and enthusiasm for including others into social spaces. The Social Programming Chair's responsibilities are to implement the necessary details to bring FYSH programs into action. Social chair is the FYSH event planner for First Year Students of Hillel programming. The Social Programming Chair is an outgoing, and enthusiastic leader, one who is adept to social cues, ready and willing to step into social settings and include others.

**Tikkun Olam Chair:** The Mitzvot chairman provides opportunities for IU students to engage in community service in the Bloomington - Monroe County district. Mitzvot chairman will meet bi-weekly with their Hillel advisor and the V.P. of Tikkun Olam to brainstorm ways to provide continual student involvement within the community.

**Jewish Education Chair:** The Jewish Education Chair brings a personal passion and willingness to learn approach to Judaism. This position is responsible for partnering with Hillel staff to incorporate engaging Jewish content into FYSH meetings and programs such as: bringing Jewish quotes to weekly meetings, students offering a 3-5 minute d'var at meetings, incorporating Jewish values, food, or holidays into the theme of planned programs. Jewish themed programs have been: Latke Cooking Competition, Hamentashen Bake

**Social Media and Marketing Chair:** The Marketing Chair brings an enthusiasm for creativity, the ability to delegate, and is able to meet deadlines. The Social Media and Marketing Chair partners with Hillel staff to create relevant social media content for FYSH programs and events. This position is responsible for delegating or distributing printable and digital flyers for events, taking flyers around campus to post on billboards, and partner with our Greek Life Social Media Coordinator to market student led initiatives for Hillel.
